RYNPARK GARDEN CLUB by Sandra Jakobi

**"LEARN CHARACTER FROM TREES, VALUES FROM ROOTS
AND CHANGE FROM LEAVES."**

Our speaker from last month, Louis Hecker, lived up to expectations and kept our sixty odd numbers enthralled with his expert knowledge on pollinators. Our May guest speaker, Cary Godwin, will talk about a "Colourful Winter Garden" – how to make your garden colourful including a variety of different plants for the colder months. While some plants begin to slow down for the winter, cool-season flowers are just waking up – ready to add charm and cheer to your garden.

GARDEN MAINTENANCE TIPS

- When planting bulbs choose a spot where you'll enjoy their display to the fullest. Follow instructions carefully. As a rule of thumb, plant bulbs at a depth three times their height. Spring flowering bulbs dislike excessive heat radiation, so avoid planting along sunny walls or paths. Read instructions on packets carefully. Bulbs thrive in pots.
- If you are ever unsure about fertilizer or sprays, your local garden staff are ready to guide you.
- Prepare for frost in vulnerable areas – stock up on protective covers like hessian and frost cloth (not plastic sheeting) from your local nursery supplier.
- Feed Hellebores with Atlantic Fruit and Flower for a dramatic winter show.
- Remember Cyclamen hate heaters; they enjoy cold areas in the home. They should be fed every two weeks once the buds appear. The flowers last

for months and can be planted in a cool spot in the garden and kept for flowering next year. Such exciting news that we can now buy a new variety which has stunning petticoat flowers.

- Aloes and flowering succulents benefit from All Purpose fertilizer now. If you need a winter-flowering focal point with low maintenance and water requirements, plant "Andy's Yellow".
- Remember to train your Sweet Peas onto a trellis for height and fragrance.
- Citrus trees need a general fertilizer plus a handful of Epsom salts per tree.
- Even in winter pests don't take a break. Identify the pest and use the correct product to treat the plant.
- May and June are good months to transplant roses because they have entered their dormant period and will suffer less root stress.
- How often should I water in winter? The best way to know when your plants need water is to look at them. Yellow leaves can be either under or over watering. Check soil moisture, stick your finger into the soil – if it still feels dry at the first knuckle, then your plants are ready for water.

The patient must contact 083 230 8052 on WhatsApp or sms.

Please send Name, cell number and address.

Dr Gerber will get back to you during the course of the day to arrange a time suitable for you for the house call.

Dr Gerber will come to your house at the arranged time for your consultation. She will take a medical history, review all your medication, do physical examination, and take blood pressure. Blood sugar test and urine test can also be done. If you need a prescription, she will email it to your pharmacy of choice, and you may arrange delivery of your medication.

Payment of the R350 consultation fee can be either cash or EFT. You will be issued a receipt for tax deduction or to claim from your medical aid.

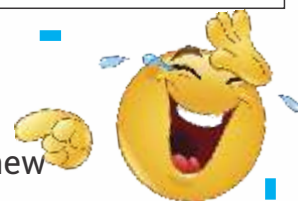
An elderly couple had dinner at another couple's house, and after eating, the wives left the table and went into the kitchen.

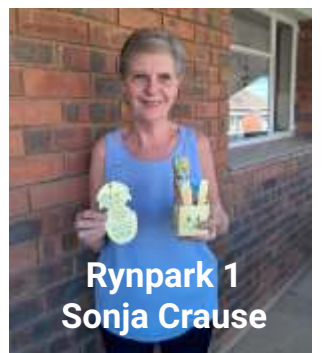
