

Springbok Peter and gardening Sandra: the Jakobi story...

Roy: I remember the buzz in Benoni hockey circles in the mid-1960s and doing the story as a young sports reporter on the Benoni City Times: a current Springbok player, Peter Jakobi (pronounced Jackabee) has come to settle in Benoni and play for a local club! And now I bump into you again some 60 years later at Rynpark with wife Sandra who needs no introduction to particularly the many Rynpark gardening enthusiasts...

Peter: Yes! We've been very happy here in Rynpark 4 now for 14 years.

Roy: Not too sure many people here are aware of the fact that you are a Springbok. How did it all come about?

Peter: born in Queenstown (Koman), is one of six siblings. His father, Percy, was a Springbok soccer player in the 1920s, and his son Dean represented South Africa in Under-21 hockey. Peter attended Queen's College Boys' High School, where he became its first Springbok, and played squash and hockey, representing Border alongside his brother and Sandra's brothers.

Roy: How did the two of you end up in Benoni?

Peter: After receiving my Springbok colours in 1966, I was headhunted through a squash connection while working in banking. The move to Benoni was arranged, and I joined Old Benonians with the help of well-known local sports figures Fred Zackey and Bobby Gagel.

Roy: Who did you represent South Africa against as a Springbok?

Peter: Unfortunately South Africa was already being isolated by many international sporting bodies at the time so we only managed to play a 'rebel' Spanish side and the then Rhodesia a couple of times.

Roy: I believe both of you spent your childhood years in the same Queenstown neighbourhood?

Sandra: Yes, in the same street, in fact, and I was the only girl among the friends in the street! After school I did my teacher training at Grahamstown Teacher Training College and took up a teaching post in Kimberley.

Roy: You were married in 1968 and once settled in Benoni, ended up teaching at virtually all the town's junior schools from what I gather...?

Sandra: I was still teaching in Kimberley when Peter moved to Benoni. Peter was actually interviewed on my behalf by Benoni Junior School principal, Miss Collins, before I arrived - and I got the job! From there I was promoted to Rynfield Primary then to Tom Newby as head of department and also swimming coach. After retiring I went back to teaching part-time at Farrarmere Primary mainly to help with the swimming and only gave that up quite recently.

Roy: And Peter, you also started "teaching", coaching hockey to be more precise...?

Peter: When I was forced to retire from hockey with an arthritis issue in the mid-1970s, another well-known Benoni sports personality, John Stanley, convinced me to coach the Benoni Northerns hockey sides. I then left banking and took an interest in a sports shop in Corlett Drive, near the Wanderers cricket ground in Joburg, where I became very friendly with renowned SA cricketer (and soccer player), Jimmy Cook, who took a late interest in hockey and joined our veterans side! I also coached the Transvaal Under 21s, then the senior provincial side, before coaching the Wits University premier league side for four to five years until I retired.

Roy: And you remained in Benoni all this time? Where in particular?

Peter: After the sports shop I went back to banking. We lived with our two children, daughter Taryne (now in New Zealand with a daughter), and son Dean (now in Australia with twin sons and a daughter), in Genevieve Street, Farrarmere, for many years. We then moved to the Oval (should have come here!) for seven years and then here 14 years ago.

Roy: Wonderful memories — thank you both for sharing them.

Sandra and Peter's passion for gardening helped transform Rynpark into a flourishing community, with their much-loved Open Gardens projects raising funds for local parks and frail care while inspiring a lasting love for gardening among residents and visitors alike.

RYNPARK GARDEN CLUB by Sandra Jakobi

Once again we were entertained by our speaker, Cary Godwin from Peebles Plants, on their uses in our gardens. She was a fountain of information and we certainly learnt a great deal.

GARDEN MAINTENANCE TIPS

- Water deeply once a week or when necessary in the morning so that the soil and foliage is dry by evening.
- Keep Clivias dry. This will initiate flower spikes.
- The ground should have cooled sufficiently to plant those much-loved bulbs by now.
- Plant herbs between your flowers and bulbs; they are not only delicious and healthy, but help to keep pests away
- Watch out for cutworm as they feed at night and hide just below the surface during the day. If necessary, drench with a caterpillar insecticide.
- Succulents and aloes add colour to the garden with their bright foliage. Shorter day lengths, cooler temperatures and drier conditions enhance the colour of the leaves. Beware; many of these plants do not like severe winter frost.
- Protect plants that might be affected by frost and use fallen leaves as mulch.
- I love winter because four of my favourite annuals are on show. These are: primulas, poppies, pansies and petunias. Firstly, the Primula family love the shady areas of your garden. Morning sun and afternoon shade. Iceland Poppies need the sunniest spot in the garden. This annual is perfect planted between dormant rose bushes. They have a delicate root system, so be careful when transplanting from seedling trays. Petunias are better in winter because like the poppy, the rain damages the flowers. What can we say about the last P in our winter annuals? There is virtually no colour you can think of that is not represented in the Pansy range. Plant where they get winter sun and in summer they get a little shade. Pansies and their cousins, Violas, will flower for months on end if they are dead headed regularly.
- Move potted plants to sheltered areas as June is one of the coldest months of the year.
- Don't prune roses too early, Wait for July.
- Don't forget to mulch around plants and flower beds to keep roots warmer and reduce weeds.
- Work compost into your garden beds to improve soil health during the dormant season. Healthy soil means stronger plants in spring.
- Winter can be difficult for birds to find food and water. Put out fresh water and bird-friendly seeds to attract beautiful birdlife to your garden.

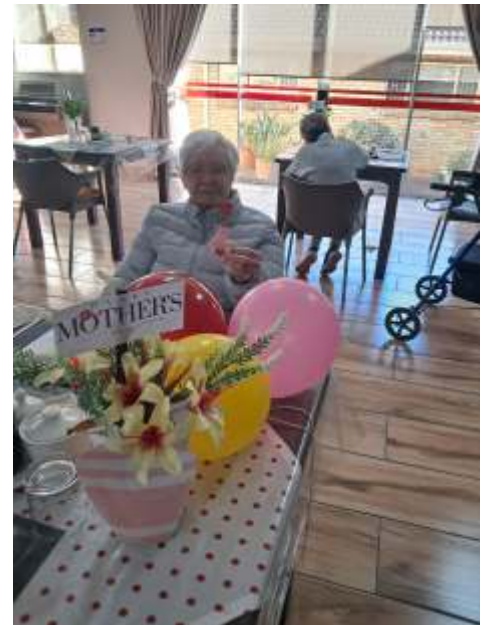

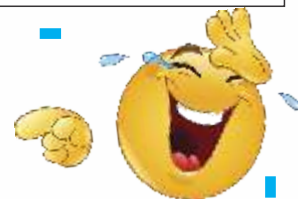
