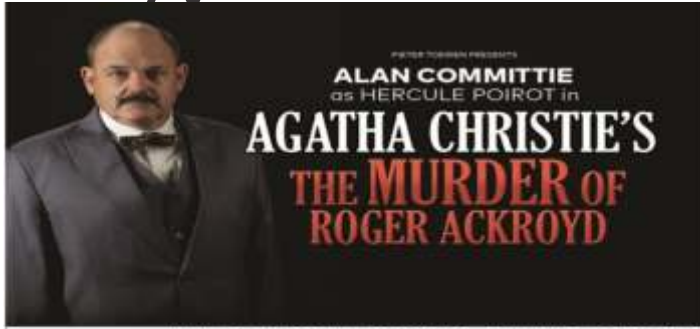
WIE BEPAAL?

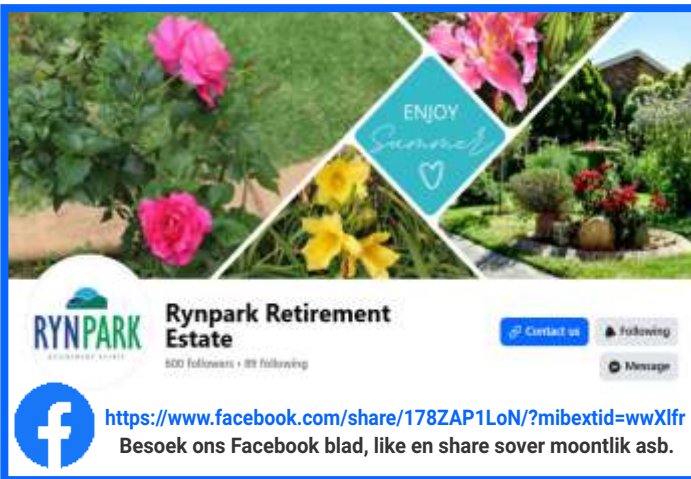

GARDEN CLUB by Sandra Jakobi

Our speaker in July, Freddy of TV fame, was an absolute gem! He entertained us with his dance moves – and a wealth of gardening knowledge, which was presented in his signature relaxed, friendly manner. Our garden club members were all spoilt by Freddy's generosity. He donated prizes and gift seedlings to everyone!

Although the month of August is not a hot favourite amongst gardeners, it does bring with it the promise of spring, heralded by the sweet scent of jasmine in the air. You need to finish



off the mundane but necessary tasks now and then you will have plenty of time for the enjoyable planting.

The most important part of pruning is the after care. First, if the soil needs improvement, dig compost into the soil around the plant's roots to a depth of around 10cm. Add a layer of mulch to keep in the moisture and reduce weeds. Start watering the roses more frequently.

Once a week at the early stages and then twice weekly as the roses begin to sprout new growth. If you have problems with pests and diseases attacking open cuts, paint these areas with Steriseal. Spray the pruned roses with a solution



of lime sulphur to protect the plant from infections. A rose that is not pruned will, over time, weaken, lose its shape and may even become sickly and prone to pests, diseases and weather damage.

August is a difficult month in the garden. It is not quite spring or winter, but somewhat in between. If there are gaps in the garden, what are the options? Choose plants that don't mind the cold initially and are still happy to grow into the warmer months like alyssum, aquilegias, snapdragons, pansies and petunias. Keep picking the flowers of Iceland poppies, Violas and Pansies regularly to ensure constant blooming. Acid-loving plants are those that require acidic soil in order to thrive. Azaleas, camellias, hydrangeas and blueberries are a few examples. Giving your acid-loving plants a treatment in late winter to early spring sets them up for better flowering and healthier foliage as the growing season begins. Pine needles and oak leaves are naturally acidic.

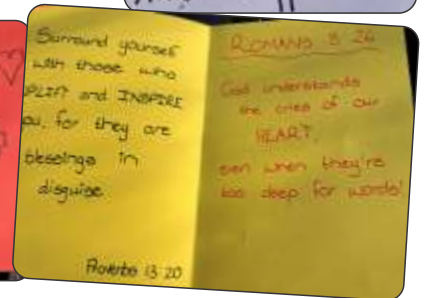
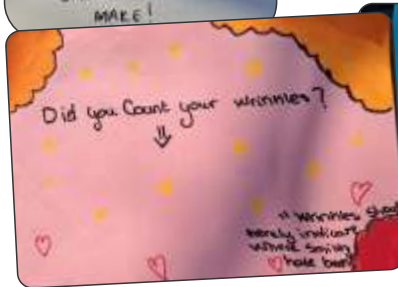

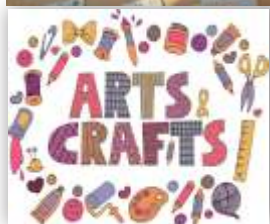


The Importance of Holy Communion

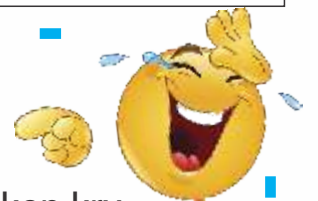
